Critical Components for Spreading the Gospel:

1. The Commission:

Every believer is commissioned to deliver the Good News

2. The Communication:

We must be prepared to accurately articulate the Gospel message

3. The Content:

The Gospel message must clearly explain who Jesus Christ is and what He has done for us

4. The Conviction:

Conviction demands a choice and this results in a decision regarding Jesus Christ

5. The Call:

When one hears, believes and responds to the Gospel it will result in salvation every time

- 1. The one who brings the Good News of the Gospel has "beautiful feet"
- 2. Not everyone will obey the Gospel
